

Positioning of BABOK study group

- We are organising a **study group**, not a lecture series. We will not focus on teaching business analysis techniques. Rather, we will be sharing and discussing real life cases and examples with participants, and support participants as they work on their own cases.
- The study group is stretched over a **longer period of time**, enabling learning by applying in each participant's work context and getting feedback along the way from peers and coaches.
- We look at the whole of **BABOK**, which is a community-based and consensus-driven global standard in business analysis, developed with the contribution of 150 writers and researchers from 20 countries.
- We work towards **certification** (not mandatory).

Study group approach



- Participants prepare each session by going through the relevant BABOK parts up front
- Typically 6 weeks between sessions
- Online forum for continuous discussion in between evening sessions
 - Facilitated by IIBA Brussels Chapter board members
 - Ensures active participation and collaboration
- Study group ending
 - Participants can opt for certification
 - Some participants are already certified and only desire re-certification
 - We consider having participants present a personal / group case at the end




Study group approach

BABOK v3 Knowledge Areas



We will discuss the different BABOK knowledge areas in a different order than the BABOK, in order to align with a typical project approach:

- Start with *Elicitation & Collaboration* to capture (initial) needs and requirements
- Then discuss the core knowledge areas Strategy Analysis, Requirements Analysis and Design Definition, Solution Evaluation as part of a normal strategy → solution process
- Next discuss *Requirements Life Cycle Management* to follow up on requirements throughout the project
- Close with *Business Analysis Planning and Monitoring* as it's easier to think about planning and monitoring things that have already been discussed
